

SUN

weather

A star that is the center of the solar system and that provides light and heat to the planets.

CLOUD

weather

A visible mass of condensed water vapor in the sky, typically high above the ground.

RAIN

weather

Water that falls from the sky in the form of drops, especially from clouds.

SKY

weather

The space above the earth that is filled with air and the clouds.

SNOW

Frozen water crystals that fall from the sky like rain, but when it is cold enough outside.

WIND

weather

Moving air that is naturally occurring, especially as it affects the earth's surface.

FOG

weather

Water vapor that has become visible, especially at or near the surface of the earth, and that reduces visibility.

STORM

weather

A violent event in which there is strong wind, heavy rain, and often thunder and lightning.
